If siblings are in different groups, we ask you to drop off and collect at the earlier time and they will be looked after in their bubble by their class teacher.

Our pupils will be kept in their bubbles all day following the government's guidelines, with rigorous cleaning and sanitising throughout the day. We will continue to operate the 'send nothing into school from home guidance,' other than a packed lunch and a water bottle. It would be a help us if your child's packed lunch could be in a disposable carrier bag. We will provide all stationary for your child, so please no pencil cases, toys or anything from home, if this advice changes we will let you know immediately.

To enable home learning, we will promote the use of Lexia for reading and TT rockstars for times table practice, all log in details will be sent out in September. Alongside this, we will be investigating in the use of our website for the setting and return of homework through the class pages- similar to how we have used it during lockdown.

We are delighted to have received funding from the Department for Education for a new heating system. As school will be a building site for the next few weeks, please ensure you do not enter any school grounds over the summer holiday – for everyone's safety.
