Testing for people without symptoms

Residents of the Staffordshire Moorlands are being encouraged to book a COVID test twice a week – even if they have no symptoms.

We know that one in three people, who have the virus, show no symptoms, so it is important we identify more of the "silent spreaders" of the virus if we are to break the chain of infection.

While the roll out of the vaccine has brought hope, it will be several months before everyone is vaccinated and many more months before they reach the full benefit of the vaccine. That's why we need to keep testing, even if you have had the vaccine.
