Attendance

Just a reminder that all children should be in school every day unless they are sick or self-isolating. The children have missed so much time in school due to lockdown that every day in school is now even more important.

If your child is not able to attend school, you must contact the office as soon as possible on the first day of absence. Reasons for absence are recorded on your child's attendance record.

Please note as part of our safeguarding requirements, we do monitor all absences including reasons and which day the absence falls upon. If we have concerns with the frequency of absences, we have a duty of care to question why this is occurring.
