Word list – years 5 and 6
Homophones and other words that are often confused
Words containing the letter-string ough
Verb prefixes: dis-, mis-, de-, re-, over-
Words with the /i:/ sound spelt <i>ei</i> after <i>c</i>
Words with 'silent' letters (i.e. whose presence cannot be predicted from the pronunciation of the word)
<ul> <li>Endings which sound like /∫əs/ spelt -cious or -tious</li> </ul>
Converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes: -ate, -ise, -ify
Words ending in -able/-ably and -ible/-ibly
Endings which sound like /ʃəl/ (-cial and -tial)
Singular and plural possessive apostrophe
Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer
Use of the hyphen
Words ending in -ant, -ance/-ancy
Words ending in -ent, -ence/-ency
