The Valley Primary School

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During the Spring 2 term, Class 1 will have P.E. on a **Monday** and **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit (including footwear) in school on these days, including an outdoor kit.

Additionally, Class 1 will take part in swimming sessions on a **Tuesday afternoon**. Children are welcome to come to school in PE kits to make it easier for them to get changed for swimming.

Homework this term will consist of spellings practice for Years 1 and 2 (which is available on the school website), **daily reading practice** of between 10 and 20 minutes a day for Y2, 5 and 10 minutes a day for Y1 and 5 minutes a day for Reception. **Read Write Inc** books will also be sent home on a Friday for children in years 1 and 2. These will be fully decodable and children will need to practice these to build up fluency. **These books will need to be returned to school by the following Wednesday at the latest.**

Years 1 & 2 will also be asked to practice TT Rockstars 2 – 3 times a week, with stage appropriate tables being set for them.

It is greatly beneficial to your child when home and school work together as it enables them to flourish in all areas of school life. If you require any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will do my best to assist.
