Computing	We Are Musicians.

Music	Exploring Arrangements.

During the Autumn Term, Class 2 will have P.E. on a **Thursday** and **Friday**. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit (including footwear) in school on these days, including an outdoor kit.
