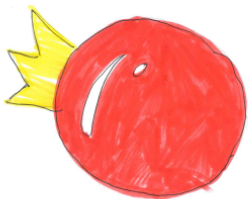

We are delighted to tell you that Bluebell Bakes will be returning to Great Wood on Friday 15th March.

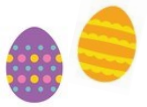
